The School of Teacher Education, Malmö University, has the pleasure of welcoming you to the ETEN meeting in September. The meetings will be in our new harbour-front premises at the School of Teacher Education (building 1 on the attached map). All the activities – except for the guided tour on Saturday afternoon – will be close to the city centre and within easy walking distance.

Saturday, September 22 ECO/TIG leader meeting in the morning

Evening: Dinner and entertainment at the Malmö Art Gallery

A more detailed programme will be sent to you in August.

The meeting fee of 270 Euros includes coffee/tea, two lunches, three dinners (Thursday, Friday and Saturday) as well as cultural events. Accommodation is paid for separately on the day of departure. Breakfast and service charges are included in the hotel rates. Hotel rooms have been reserved and I need to confirm the reservations a month in advance.

- ✓ By plane to Copenhagen (easiest) or Malmö Airport; direct train from Copenhagen Airport across the bridge to Malmö Central station – and then an easy walk to the hotel; from Malmö Airport by airport bus to the central station (90 SEK). If you take a taxi, please ask for a fixed price beforehand (appr. 400 SEK).
- ✓ By train to the Central station.

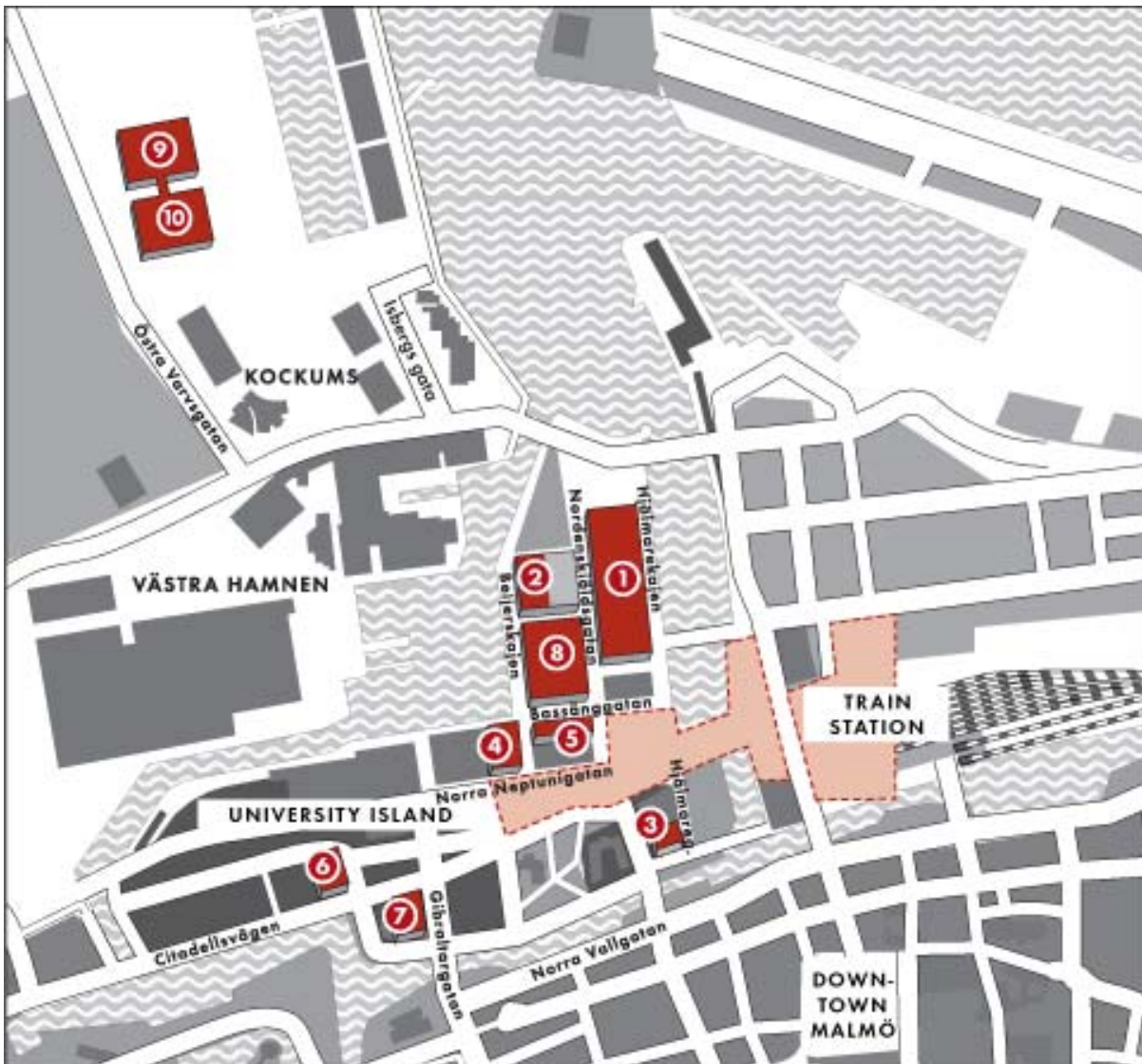
