The publication process of the 21st ETEN conference proceedings

- ❖ Conference presenters send their papers to the TIG leaders by **May 30, 2011**
- ❖ TIG leaders go through the papers
- ❖ TIG leaders send appropriate papers to the editors by **June 15, 2011** auli.toom@helsinki.fi
- ❖ Publication of ETEN 2011 conference proceedings (September 2011) on ETEN website



The publication process of JETEN volume 7

- ❖ TIG leaders choose 2(-3) Proceedings articles and send them to **auli.toom@helsinki.fi** by **1.10.2011**
- ❖ The editors send the articles to two referees
- ❖ The referees are asked to send their comments and suggestions by **15.11.2011**
- ❖ The authors get their referee comments and return their revised articles by **31.1.2012**
- ❖ JETEN will be published by **31.3.2012**

- ❖ Referees are (still and continuously) needed 😊
